Are you looking to upskill and return to work?

If so, Shaping Futures is an exciting programme which is designed to give participants the necessary skill sets to take up employment or progress on to further education.

The Shaping Futures programme is a QQI accredited programme with participants working towards a QQI Level 4 major award in Employment Skills. The course includes 9 modules, volunteer work and an 8-week workplace internships. While on the programme participants receive one to one support and guidance to help in identifying their ideal career path.

Shaping Futures is a yearlong full time programme **starting 9th September 2024**. The venue for the course will be based in our INOU Learning Hub, Townsend Street, Dublin 2.

While training you will receive an ETB training allowance, meal allowance, travel allowance and your secondary social welfare payments will not be affected. We also offer canteen facilities which includes free cereal and snacks. Learners also have access to childcare places under the National Childcare Scheme.
