- Experience of providing therapy to children, adults, and families.
- · Primary or higher degree in related discipline.
- · Recognized therapy qualification.
- Knowledge of Children First Guidance.

The role involves the provision of therapy to children and adolescents affected by child sexual abuse. The role also includes
