This role will be responsible for leading on our donor relationship, acquisition, retention, and cultivation strategies to build our communities of support to increase income across our fundraising mix. You will be a people focused, relationship builder who will work with colleagues to develop clear, well thought out supporter recruitment strategies. You will be responsible for leading on our extensive donor communications program to inspire, recruit and retain our growing community of supporters.

Who we are:

Established (as Headstrong) in 2006, Jigsaw is Ireland's leading youth mental charity and is committed to advancing young people's mental health and to developing supportive communities by providing a range of early intervention primary care services and supports across the Republic of Ireland.

With the support of a range of public and private funders, we deliver free mental health services and supports for young people and adults including:

- Free therapy with young people (aged 12-25) in-person across 14 regional hubs and online via phone and video
- community-based programmes aimed at better informing, supporting, educating and empowering young people and those around them, in places where they live, learn, work and play
- pioneering research and robust evaluation leading to transformative evidence
- a wide range of online mental health supports, services and programmes through [jigsaw.ie](https://www.jigsaw.ie)
