The Role of the Advocate:

- Provide a one-to-one support to Young People and Families for up to 15 hours per week (€16.07 PER HOUR)
- Build a trusting relationship with young people & parents /carers
- · Work with young people and families to achieve their goals
- · Identify and link young people and families with the appropriate community supports
- · Support young people to identify their interests and support parents/carers with parenting

Advocates report to Team Leaders and with their support develop a strengths-based, needs-led Individual Service Plan (ISP) with the young person and family.

Advocates Requirements: You need to be:

- · A good listener and a positive role model
- · Available for flexible working hours, evenings and weekends
- Interested in your community and want to make a difference
- · Have a full driving license and access to your own transport
- · Advocates are required to attend fortnightly supervisions and monthly team meetings
