As part of St Stephen's Green Trust's (SSGT) strategic goal to contribute to a more humane asylum system in Ireland and our decade-long commitment to supporting people in the international protection (IP) system, we are making funding available in 2024 for organisations with a track-record of advocacy work in relation to migrant issues.

This year's funding will focus on supporting groups with a proven track record of advocacy work in relation to issues affecting people in IP so that they can make time and space for strategic thinking, with a view to addressing one or more of the issues outlined in our paper, through strategic advocacy.
