- Recruit and train volunteers to support the activities of your Project
- Manage all aspects of the project on a national level
- Project Development: planning, managing, reporting and executing against a set of defined project outcomes set out in the No Shame strategic plan.
- Community Support: Supporting a regional network of youth organisations, youth workers and volunteers to deliver the No Shame Programme with young people from the Traveller community
