With over 100 medical responders, including emergency medical technicians (EMTs), paramedics, consultants, and other qualified medical professionals, CRITICAL works in partnership with the National Ambulance Service (NAS) and responds to life-threatening emergencies.

CRITICAL envisions an Ireland where communities and those living in it have equal opportunities to receive a rapid medical response in the event of a medical emergency, injury, accident, or trauma.
