- Applicants for these contracts must have a minimum of three years' experience facilitating / training with adult learners in the area of children and or families.
- A Level 6 FETAC Training (Train the Trainer) or the equivalent.
- Knowledge of the education system is also desirable. Our training programmes have a clear focus on parenting and full training will be given.
- A full clean driver's license is required.
- Applicants must be prepared to travel.

Cavan, Donegal, Galway, Kildare, Laois, Limerick, Mayo, Meath, Monaghan, Sligo, Tipperary and Wexford.
