Safe Harbour uses beautiful illustrations by <u>Bronagh Lee (https://www.bronaghlee.com/)</u> and a gentle story to guide children through their feelings after losing someone to suicide. The book aims to help them make sense of their emotions and find a sense of safety and support.

What's Inside the Book

Safe Harbour is a story told by a young child whose Dad has died by suicide. It uses words and illustrations that a child can relate to.

The book is designed to be read with an adult, allowing children to ask questions and share their thoughts as they go along. It's not just about reading a story; it's about creating a space where children feel heard and understood. The book also comes with a guide for parents or carers.
