- a level 7 qualification or higher in Youth Work, Community Work, Social Studies or Social Care.
- a minimum of 3 years' experience of working in a youth work setting with 'at-risk' young people in a paid capacity.
- experience of developing positive working relationships with young people, their families and communities.
- experience of working as part of a team.
- experience of working on an inter-agency basis with a range of partners.

### **They must also:**

- Have a good working knowledge of the youth work sector in Ireland
- Have excellent interpersonal and communication skills and strong recording, writing, reporting and evaluation skills & experience.
- Be willing to work evenings, unsocial hours and a time off in lieu system.
- Have a full clean driving license and own transport.

The successful candidates will be employed by **In Sync** Youth & Family Services on a fixed-term contract, with a scheduled start date in December 2024. Closing date for applications is **1pm on Thursday 28th November 2024**.
