This programme is relevant for anyone who is passionate about improving the health and well-being of adolescents.

Delivered through a combination of online modules and monthly workshops on campus, this programme caters to recent graduates, working professionals, and distance learners. The programme can also be completed fully remote via attendance online.

Graduates will be equipped with the requisite knowledge and skills to promote and improve the health of adolescents, locally, nationally, and globally.
