This position is in collaboration with the Probation Service and works specifically with young people who are known to the Probation Service and Youth Justice Systems. This exciting role will work with young people on an intensive 1:1 basis to address offending behaviour through home visits, individual support, advocacy and developmental programming.

If you are passionate about working with young people and have a particular interest in youth justice this could be the role for you.

Requirements:

- A third level degree (or equivalent) in the fields of social work, social care, humanities, or a related discipline
- A minimum of 3 years’ experience of working with vulnerable and at-risk young people/their families/carers and relevant professionals
- Experience of working with young people on Probation and known to the criminal justice system
- The ability to work effectively with identified young people and their families/carers experiencing significant trauma and complexity
- Experience of working in structured and individualised settings with young people, delivering one to one intensive support to facilitate desistance from offending behaviour.
- Enthusiasm, flexibility, and can-do attitude
- Full driving licence and access to a car for work purposes
