Founded in 1989, our organisation has extensive expertise in providing a wide range of specialist, holistic support services. Our services are **free, confidential**, and delivered by a **committed and experienced team**. Ruhama also advocates to influence policy that supports and protects women.

The Regional Manager, based in Cork or Limerick, will lead and develop front line teams based regionally, currently in Limerick mid-west, Cork/Kerry and Midlands and will manage and develop care pathways, to ensure quality and effective service delivery for all Ruhama service users.

Details

- Full-Time role - 35 hours per week
- Competitive Salary Scale - €53,700-€59,400 (depending on experience)

Benefits of working with Ruhama

- 25 days annual leave per annum.
- 2 additional privilege days per annum.
- WFH options – normally 1 day per week, following successful probation.
- Ruhama operates a contributory pension scheme, which all employees may join on completion of successful probation period
- Death in Service Benefit through our pension scheme: Available for all employees after 6 months (successful probation period), to the value of 3 times annual salary.
- Maternity leave: at full salary (less Social Welfare benefits), subject to one years' service, for the period of the 26 weeks paid leave.
- Parent's Leave: 9 weeks' leave topped up to full salary, subject to one year's service during the first 2 years of a child's life or in the case of adoption, within 2 years of the placement of the child with the family for eligible employees.
- Travel Supports: Bike-to-work schemes and tax saver commuter tickets.
- Employee Assistance Programme with VHI.
- Suite of Training Programmes to develop skillset as part of induction, probation and ongoing CPD.
