The Post:

Candidates must:

1. Hold an undergraduate degree in youth work, or cognate discipline
2. Hold a relevant postgraduate award with three years' experience post qualification
3. Be NSETS endorsed
4. A minimum of two year's lecturing experience at third level in Youth Work is desirable
5. Ideally candidates will be familiar with Youth Work practice in Ireland and Northern Ireland.

As an Assistant Lecturer, duties include but are not limited to:

- Delivery of Lectures and tutorial support including assessment.
- Administration supervision.
- Practice supervision.
- Maintaining sector engagement.

Remuneration:

Remuneration will be paid at the appropriate hourly rate which currently is €66.34 (Assistant Lecturer Part-time less 10% if commenced from 2011 onwards), and as approved by the Minister for Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science.
