This exciting role will work with young people on an intensive 1:1 basis to address offending behaviour through home visits, individual support, advocacy and developmental programming.

If you are passionate about working with young people and have a particular interest in youth justice this could be the role for you.

- The ability to work effectively with identified young people and their families/carers experiencing significant trauma and complexity
- Experience of working in structured and individualised settings with young people, delivering one to one intensive support to facilitate desistance from offending behaviour.

- Full driving licence and access to a car for work purposes
