This exciting role will work with young people, their parents/guardians and families referred to the Candle Service on a 1:1 basis. The role will support engagement and participation through home visits, individual support, advocacy and developmental programming with both the young person and their family. The role is also supported by and works with the diverse range of services within the Candle centre.
