# Join Our Team as a Community Energy Communications Officer

Energy Communities Tipperary Cooperative, trading as EcoVision, is seeking a passionate and driven individual to fill the role of Community Energy Communications Officer for the EU Just Transition Fund Community Retrofit Coordination project within the Thurles and Carrick-on-Suir Municipal Districts. This role offers an exciting opportunity to contribute meaningfully to Ireland's energy transition, while making a tangible impact on local communities.

# **Energy Communities Tipperary Cooperative Background**

Energy Communities Tipperary Cooperative CLG (ECTC), trading as EcoVision, is a not-for-profit organisation, whose vision is to mobilise communities in Tipperary and surrounding areas to reduce the carbon footprint of their built environment, thereby creating local employment and community benefits.

## **Role Overview: Community Energy Communications Officer**

As the Community Energy Communications Officer, you will play a pivotal role in driving the Community Retrofit Coordination programme, which aims to increase the uptake in energy efficiency upgrades in the Thurles and Carrick-on-Suir Municipal Districts.

### The Community Energy Communications Officer will achieve this by:

- Working as part of a collaborative team to develop and drive our sales and marketing strategy.
- Co-designing and executing the communication strategy to engage communities and homeowners. This may include creation of content, social media posts, newsletters and relevant templates.
- Supporting the Community Energy Coordinator to engage homeowners, businesses, and community groups. This may include developing and delivering presentations to local groups.
- Serving as an initial point of contact for homeowners, local businesses, and community groups enquiring about energy upgrades, and determining their eligibility to participate in our scheme.
- Supporting EcoVision's other community development work in the Thurles and Carrick-on-Suir Municipal Districts
  which contribute to the success of the Community Retrofit Coordination project e.g. attending networking events and
  shows
- · Maintaining a foundational understanding of Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland (SEAI) grants
- Engaging in continuous learning and professional development to stay abreast of industry trends.
- Reporting regularly to the General Manager.

#### CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

#### The ideal candidate will have the following characteristics:

- A qualification in Marketing or Sales, or similar would be a key advantage, otherwise the candidate should demonstrate experience in sales and marketing.
- A proficiency in social media and digital skills is a must.
- Additionally, the candidate should have strong communication skills and the ability to work collaboratively as part of a team.
- Some community development experience, particularly with rural voluntary groups and community energy projects, is highly advantageous.
- An understanding of the Energy Transition and Energy Democracy principles would be welcome.
- Highly motivated with a proactive attitude and the ability to work independently in a primarily remote, home working
  environment.
- Ability to travel with own car and a full clean driver's licence.
- The candidate must reside in the Thurles or Carrick-on-Suir Municipal District
