# **Executive Director**

**CONTRACT:** Full-time, permanent position, following completion of a 6-month probationary period (a 4-day working week may be considered).

The Executive Director is a senior leadership role within a small, agile nonprofit with an all-Ireland remit, with overall responsibility for delivering the vision and mission of St Stephen's Green Trust (SSGT) in close collaboration with the Chairperson and Board of Trustees (Board).

The role is dual-faceted – the Executive Director serves as both a strategic leader and a hands-on Programme Manager for the criminal justice and family matters sectors, guiding the organisation's operations, relationships, and strategic direction.

Responsibilities include the development, recommendation to the Board, and implementation of strategy and policies; the development and implementation of grant-making programmes and procedures as well as the necessary governance, financial, personnel and administrative systems to effectively run the funded organisations, and the representation of SSGT to grantee and other community and statutory organisation, the media and others as appropriate.
