The person we are seeking will be enthusiastic, highly motivated and will have the ability to work as part of a multidisciplinary team in a community based project.

The main tasks include:

- · Carrying out therapy/counselling assessments with young people
- Providing counselling and therapy to young people with substance use/misuse
- · Facilitate sessions with individuals, groups or families
- · Referrals to residential detox/treatment programmes
- · Out of hours/evening work
- · Creating a supportive environment
- · Attendance at clinical team meetings
- · Maintaining records computerised and report writing
