Role Description	The role of an Outdoor Education Instructor in The Cavan Centre is to provide structured outdoor education experiences that promote personal development, resilience, and social inclusion. The focus is on delivering safe and engaging residential programs that use outdoor activities to encourage teamwork, confidence-building, and life skills development. The target group for outdoor education in this setting includes young people and families facing social or personal disadvantage, providing them with opportunities to connect, learn, and grow in a supportive outdoor environment.
Key Duties	
	 To instruct & lead individuals & groups in the various activities. To operate all activities according to required operational standards & best practice as set out by The Cavan Centre. To be responsible for the safety, instruction, supervision and enjoyment of those in his/her care. To be responsible for the maintenance, storing and control of all centre equipment and property. To be actively responsible for the supervision & direction of groups during non-activity periods such as mealtimes and before and after activities until such time as responsibility has been handed over to group leaders or another member of staff. To maintain appropriate skill, fitness and qualification levels to enhance instructional performance. To maintain appropriate records for group visits, programmes and accidents / incidents.

	 To assist with the design of programmes, course notes and other related administrative duties. To be fully conversant with Centre Operating Procedures, Governing Body Guidelines & statutory regulations. To attend training courses as required and to meet agreed training targets for NGB qualifications. To stay overnight in the residential setting and provide support,
	supervision, and assistance to groups and families participating in residential programs, ensuring a safe, welcoming, and supportive environment throughout their stay.
